

A Ministry Area is a group of former parishes together.

Each church is now an individual part of the Ministry Area.

What is the MAC? **02.**

The MAC is the Ministry Area Council, this replaces the old PCC.

Each church now has its own Local Church Council (LCC) to discuss its own plans and wellbeing. It can make recommendations to the MAC.

The MAC are Trustees of our charity; only they can authorise expenditure and building works.

O3. Who is my vicar now?

Pastoral care hasn't changed: your old vicar is still your vicar for now.

You may see other clergy from the MA from time to time

Who is in charge of the Ministry Area?

The Ministry Area Council has overall control, as Trustees.

There are two Wardens (David-Lloyd, Gareth Baker, a Ministry Area Leader (Fr Jon) and a Chair appointed by the Bishop (Wendy Xerri).

Where does my giving go?

Your giving goes to the same church as it did before.

We all have the same purpose: to live and share the Gospel. Our joint services help us to get to know one another and help us work together better as Christian Growing Together in Christ, as our emblem says.
